Vineyard Notes

Fruit is sourced from the Murrumong Vineyard in Coldstream, one of the few vineyards in the Yarra Valley planted with this variety. Located approximately 150m above sea level it covers some of the most uniform clay loam soil profiles across the whole vineyard. A unique, drought proof vineyard with ample water, north-east facing with majestic views to Healesville in the east.

Winemakers Notes

Grapes were stored in a cool room overnight, then whole bunch pressed the next day. Cloudy juice then went into old barrels for fermentation, utilising a mixture of wild and aromatic yeasts. Post ferment the wine stayed in oak on full solids for 4 months. No fining agents used. Single filtration prior to bottling.
