Our Cosa Nostra wines are an exploration of Adrian's Italian family history and our obsession with beautiful Italian varietals which in many cases, are also so well suited to our climate - low environmental impact, high drinking pleasure. It's our thing and we love it.

Grapes

100% Yarra Valley single vineyard Pinot Grigio

Winemaking Notes

Fruit was hand-picked from a single vineyard in the Yarra Valley. Grapes were whole bunch pressed and left on lees for 5 months to add complexity. Post ferment the wine stayed in 50% old oak and 50% stainless tank (to retain freshness of aromatics) for 4 months. Unfined and only a single filtration prior to bottling.
